MAS has partnered with a Mississippi-domiciled Third Party Administrator (TPA) to provide inmate medical/RX savings as well as competent and efficient claims administration to MAS member counties. These claims auditors each have over 10 years of experience in claims administration.



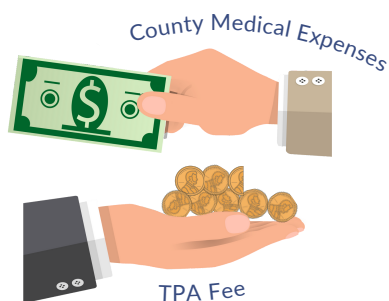
The MAS Inmate Medical Cost Containment Program provides the following services to member counties

- ✓ Evaluation of medical service codes and appropriate Medicaid repricing for claims payment
- ✓ Efficient claims processing and turnaround time between billing and provider payment
- ✓ Proper coordination of benefits by intercepting Medicare eligibility (age, disability, renal failure, etc.) applicable private insurance, etc.
- ✓ Monthly, quarterly, and annual reports to county detailing total billed charges disallowed charges, charges paid, and total savings for the county
- ✓ Pre-certification of necessary services for non-emergency medical admissions

TPA fee based solely on savings found!

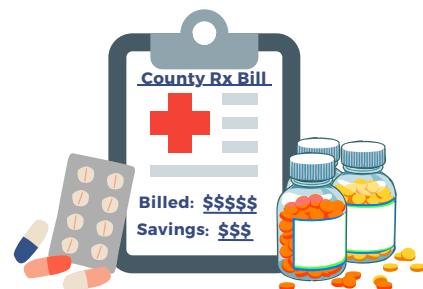
Medical Cost

Are inmate medical costs keeping county tax dollars all locked up?

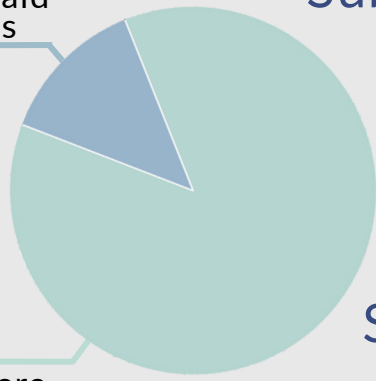


Sign up

- ✓ Contact MAS to join.
- ✓ TPA works with county for program set-up.
- ✓ TPA distributes claim cards to county.

Since July 2022 counties have saved 84% on medical costs and 72% on prescription charges.

Submit

- ✓ County presents claim card to medical providers or pharmacy.
- ✓ Medical provider sends bill directly to TPA. TPA adjudicates bills to Medicaid rate.

Save

- ✓ TPA sends a monthly invoice and savings report.
- ✓ County pays the single invoice to TPA then TPA directly pays medical providers
