## **Next Step in the Process**

Counties should now focus on understanding the <u>lost revenue calculator</u> and the use of lost revenue ARP funds as the next step in the process (Click <u>HERE</u> for calculator). The lost revenue calculator will aid your county in identifying the amount of ARP funds available in lost revenue. It is important to note that that US Treasury's IFR states that counties can use revenue recoupment dollars toward <u>any</u> government services including, but not limited to:

- Maintenance or pay-go funded building of infrastructure, including roads
- Modernization of cybersecurity, including hardware, software, and protection of critical infrastructure
- Healthcare services
- Environmental remediation
- School or educational services
- Provision of police, fire, and other public safety services

## Understanding Eligible Uses of The Fiscal Recovery Fund: How Counties Should Calculate Revenue Loss
