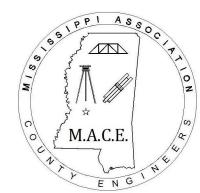

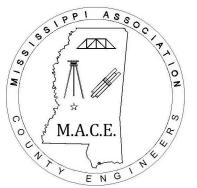

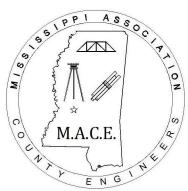

## Funds Provided by OSARC – for Bridges

- Local System Bridge Program (LSBP)
  - These funds are used for Bridges that <u>ARE NOT</u> on the State Aid Road System
  - Annual Minimum Guaranteed \$20 Million Statewide
    - One-half (1/2) on the proportion that the Total Number of Local System Bridges in your County bears to the Total Number Of Local System Bridges in the entire State.
    - One-half (1/2) on the proportion that the Total Square Footage (SF) of Deck Area of all Local System Bridges in your County bears to the Total Square Footage (SF) of Deck Area for all Local System Bridges in the entire State.

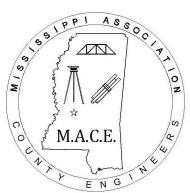
## Funds Provided by OSARC – for Bridges

- State Aid Bridge Program (SABP) NEW SOURCE OF FUNDING
- ➢ Used for Bridges that <u>ARE ON</u> the State Aid System of Roadways.
- Annual Minimum Guaranteed \$20 Million Statewide
  - One-half (1/2) on the proportion that the Total Number of State Aid System Bridges in your County bears to the Total Number Of State Aid System Bridges in the entire State.
  - One-half (1/2) on the proportion that the Total Square Footage (SF) of Deck Area of all State Aid System Bridges in your County bears to the Total Square Footage (SF) of Deck Area for all State Aid System Bridges in the entire State

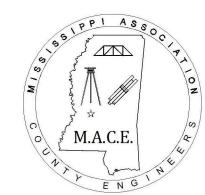

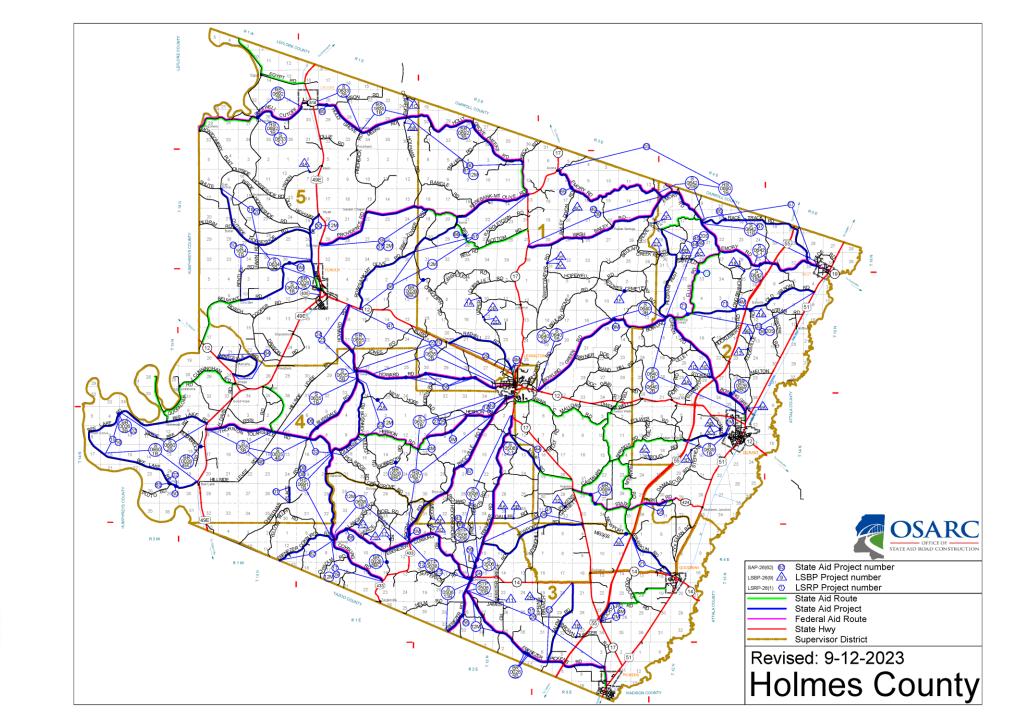

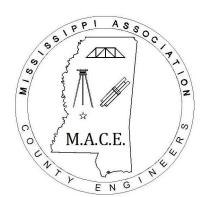
## Funds Provided by OSARC – for ROADS

- State Aid Program Revenue(SAP)
- Used for <u>Roads and Bridges</u> that <u>ARE ON</u> the State Aid System of Roadways.
  - ✤ 1/3 Equally (82 COUNTIES)
  - ✤ 1/3 By Rural Road Miles
  - ✤ 1/3 By Rural Population

  THAT DONE

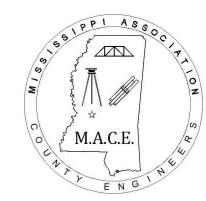




## OTHER ROLES OF A COUNTY ENGINEER

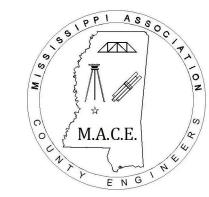
- COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANTS (CDBG)

  - Erosion Control Projects



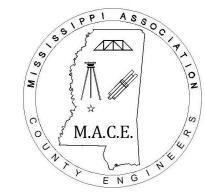
## OTHER ROLES OF A COUNTY ENGINEER

- MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY (MDEQ)
  - Borrow Pit / Gravel Pit Permitting
  - Rubbish Pit Permitting
  - Rubbish Closure
- RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION REVIEW
  - Review of Subdivions Plats and Construction Plans
  - Construction Inspection of Improvements
