

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# COLLECTION METHODS



### **FORCE ACCOUNT**

Using your own labor and equipment.

For reimbursement – documentation is heavy!



# COLLECTION METHODS

### **CONTRACT**

Depending on the volume of debris and speed of collection, could dictate whether or not an Emergency Contract is appropriate.





# COLLECTION METHODS

### **CONTRACT**

Procurement must be conducted properly.


If not, then reimbursement is in jeopardy.





### FOR FEMA REIMBURSEMENT OF CONTRACTS

"Recipients and subrecipients <u>MUST</u> comply with <u>ALL</u> applicable federal laws, regulations, and executive orders. Each non-Federal Entity is responsible for managing and administering its federal awards in compliance with the applicable requirements, including but not limited to the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards"

### JOINT BID CONTRACT

Select a State Pre-Approved Contractor to do Debris Collection and Monitoring





### **ADVANTAGES**

- Debris operations can start right after a storm.
- Contract already procured in compliance with federal procurement regulations.






### JOINT BID CONTRACT

Challenge: There is no provision in Mississippi law to allow Joint Bid for Services.



### NORTH CAROLINA MODEL




### 13 Regions

Each Region has 3 preapproved contractors for debris removal & 3 pre-approved contractors for monitoring



### NORTH CAROLINA MODEL



Local governments choosing to activate the contracts will issue a **Notice To Proceed** to the pre-positioned contractors in that region.

### **7 Regions**

- 1 Debris Contractor for Regions 1, 2, & 7
- 1 Debris Contractor for Region 6
- 1 Debris Contractor for Region 3, 4, & 5
- 1 Debris Monitoring Contractor for all Regions

### **To Activate**

Local governments choosing to activate the contracts will issue a **Notice To Proceed** to the pre-positioned contractors in that region.



### PRE-APPROVED CONTRACT

By utilizing a pre-approved State contract, it will allow counties to focus on the immediate demands of a disaster without the distraction of conducting a procurement process for debris and monitoring. It also helps to ensure that counties have contractors ready to perform debris work quickly after an incident occurs, when needed the most.

- Need <u>legislation</u> to allow Joint Bid for Services.
- Mississippi Association of Supervisors (MAS) as proponent.
- MEMA work with MAS and FEMA to ensure bid documents meet federal criteria.
- Contact your local Representative and Senator.





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# STORM DAMAGED ROADS

Permanent Work to restore roads and bridges is eligible for reimbursement if:

- They are the legal responsibility of the applicant.
- Have been maintained.

# STORM DAMAGED ROADS

"When evaluating eligibility of reported road damage, FEMA reviews maintenance records or documentation establishing that the Applicant has a routine maintenance program. In the absence of maintenance records, FEMA reviews material purchase invoices and activity logs ... to confirm the performance of regular maintenance activities."
