## **Congressional Redistricting: House Bill 384**

On Thursday, January 6, the Mississippi House of Representatives took "Floor Action" to pass **House Bill 384** by a vote of 76 to 43. The basic gist of this measure is to redraw the Mississippi's four congressional districts.

On Thursday January 6<sup>th</sup>, the U.S. Department of Treasury released the Final Rule for the State and Local Coronavirus Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLCFRF) which was authorized under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). The Final Rule will not go into effect until April 1, 2022.
