Weekly Legislative Update 2019 Regular Legislative Session January 11, 2019

THE 2019 REGULAR LEGISLATIVE SESSION

The 2019 Regular Legislative Session gaveled in at 12 noon on January 8, 2019. This session is scheduled to last 90 days.

The Deadline for making requests for general and constitutional amendments to be filed is Wednesday, January 16, 2019.

THE FIRST WEEK OF THE 2019 REGULAR LEGISLATIVE SESSION BEGINS WITH APPOINTING NEW LEADERSHIP ROLES

On Wednesday, January 9, 2018, the Speaker of the House of Representatives Representative, Philip Gunn appointed Representative Angela Cockerham as chairlady of the House Judiciary B Committee. Representative Cockerham was formerly the chairlady of the House Energy Committee. Speaker Gunn also appointed Representative Gary Staples as the new chairman of the House Energy Committee. He was formerly the vice-chairman of that committee. The changing of the chairs is due to the transition of former legislator Andy Gipson's move to State's Agriculture Commissioner.

In addition, the Senate Pro Tempore, Senator Terry Burton has resigned as Senate MS. It is scheduled for Tuesday, Pro Tempore. The Senate has elected Senator Gray Tollison as new Pro Tempore.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT DEBT COLLECTION

Senate Bill 2058: This measure authorizes counties and municipalities to collect We look forward to seeing certain debts by setoff against the debtor's state income tax refund.

NOTE: This measure is assigned to the Senate Finance Committee and has only been introduced. No action is taken on it. The deadline to pass this bill out of committee is February 5th.
